

# I LIVE HERE I GIVE HERE TO HOST 12TH ANNUAL AMPLIFY AUSTIN DAY ON MARCH 6 - 7

Austin-based nonprofit announces new Amplify Wilco Day campaign plus the addition of 75 new participating nonprofits; sponsorships from Juiceland, Amy's Ice Cream, Tito's Handmade Vodka and more.

**AUSTIN, TX (February 20, 2024)** — I Live Here I Give Here is inviting Central Texans to participate in this year's **Amplify Austin Day,** a community-wide giving event scheduled for March 6-7. The event will kick off at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, March 6, and conclude at 6 p.m. on Thursday, March 7. Residents across the seven-county Central Texas region are encouraged to make donations to support over 700 local nonprofit organizations during this 24-hour period. For the first time, I Live Here I Give Here will have over 75 new nonprofits participating, with this year's goal being to ensure every nonprofit receives a donation.

Amplify Austin Day aims to increase giving in Central Texas for hundreds of nonprofits by providing easily accessible giving opportunities via the **online Amplify ATX platform**. Donors can search for nonprofit organizations by keyword, location, and category across seven Central Texas counties: Travis, Hays, Williamson, Burnet, Bastrop, Caldwell, and Blanco. Participating nonprofits serve 19 different cause categories, including racial equity, the environment, animals, the arts, basic needs, children, and veterans.

While the official start of Amplify Austin Day is on March 6, early giving is already open at <u>AmplifyATX.org</u> for residents who wish to jumpstart donations to their favorite nonprofit. Early donations will count toward the Amplify Austin Day totals and qualify donors for early giving incentives and grand prizes. Since 2013, Amplify Austin Day has raised \$102.7 million for over 1,400 Central Texas nonprofits, demonstrating the transformative impact of donations, from \$5 and on.

This year, I Live Here I Give Here will debut a new hyper-local campaign called <u>Amplify Wilco Day</u>, benefiting over 60 Williamson County-serving nonprofits, nearly 10% of this year's nonprofit participation. Participating organizations include The Caring Place, ROCK Ride On Center for Kids, Sam's Adventure Camp, Williamson County Children's Advocacy Center, Hope Alliance, Candlelight Ranch, and more.

To keep the Amplify Austin Day momentum going, I Live Here I Give Here will host Amplify LIVE— a benefit concert celebrating the funds raised through Amplify Austin Day and I Live Here I Give Here's 17 years of impact on the Central Texas nonprofit community. This year's concert will be held on Thursday, April 18, 2024, at the Historic Scoot Inn in Austin, Texas. In collaboration with C3 Presents, the benefit concert will feature headliner Ben Kweller and performances by Kalu & The Electric Joint and THEBROSFRESH. Community members can visit **AmplifyATX.org**/<u>info/about-us</u> now to get involved as a **Fundraising Champion.** Fundraising Champions fundraise for nonprofits they love during Amplify Austin Day. Local businesses are invited to **fundraise too by** signing up their company to **become a Business Fundraiser**. Business Fundraisers are a great way to engage employees in

the community and are critical to the success of Amplify Austin Day. Employees participate by making a gift of \$5 or more to their favorite nonprofit on Amplify Austin Day, and businesses compete with each other for leaderboard recognition. In 2023, 54 Business Fundraisers brought in an additional \$814,000 on Amplify Austin Day. When you sign up as a Business Fundraiser, you create a custom fundraising page, set team goals and celebrate the community's annual day of giving. Awards and recognition will be given to the top Business Fundraisers based on employee participation and dollars raised. There is no cost to register. - Central Texas Community Foundation will match \$25,000 for Animal Care & Services and Military & Veterans nonprofits in Williamson County
- Cirrus Logic has committed to matching \$5,000 to the Amplify Fund.
- Dirdie Birdie gifting 10% of net sales proceeds on March 6 & 7 to benefit SAFE
- **Expedia Group** has committed to matching \$25,000 to the Amplify Fund.
- H-E-B is committing \$10,000 to Environment, Conservation & Sustainability cause category match

This year, Amplify Austin Day is being promoted across 30 media outlets in Central Texas. These include Waterloo Media, Austin American Statesman, Austin Business Journal, Austin Monthly, Austin PBS, Austin Woman and Community Impact.
